



Poster presentations provide an opportunity to visually communicate your research and engage in discussion with conference delegates in an informal setting.

Due to the high volume of posters and to ensure adequate engagement time, two dedicated poster presentation sessions will be held:

- Poster Session 1: Monday 3 August | 4:00pm–6:00pm
- Poster Session 2: Thursday 6 August | 4:00pm–6:00pm

### Poster Set-Up and Take-Down

- Presenters are responsible for printing and transporting their physical posters to the venue.
- Posters must be mounted on the provided fabric display boards by 10:30am (*the end of morning tea*) on the morning of your scheduled session. Mounting materials will be provided. Your poster number is the same as your submitted paper number and has been shared with you via email. Your session time will be shared closer to the event.
- All posters must be removed by 5:00pm on the day following your session.
- The EDAR8 Organising Team will not be responsible for posters left behind after these times.

### Poster Guidelines

- **Size:** Posters should be printed in A0 size (1189mmH × 841mmW) and must be in portrait orientation.
- **Title and authors:** The title must match your accepted submission. Include all author names and affiliations on the poster.
- **Presenter attendance:** Authors should be present at their poster during their assigned session and prepared to engage in discussion with EDAR8 delegates.

### Content and Design Best Practices

- All text should be legible from a distance of approximately 1.5 metres. Keep text concise, structured, and easy to read.
- If relevant, methods should be presented simply and concisely.
- Display results visually where possible; avoid large, dense tables of data. Use figures, graphics, and colour effectively to enhance clarity and engagement.
- Ensure the content aligns with the results presented in your submitted abstract.

### Digital Viewing

A PDF version of your poster must be uploaded via the Submission Portal by **Friday 31<sup>st</sup> July** for inclusion in the official Delegate App.

## Research Excellence Awards

If you have signed up the EDAR8 ECR Program and wish for your poster to be considered for a *Research Excellence Award*, you must complete your digital upload earlier—by **Friday 17<sup>th</sup> July** via the Submission Portal. During upload, you must check the selection box acknowledging that you meet the eligibility criteria and understand the assessment process requirements.
